

The bunch feeding by De - navelling and post - shooting feeding of N, K and S through the distal stalk-end

technology of Banana enhancing the size of fingers in the bunch to suit the market demands and improves successful development of rachis. Method demonstration was conducted in Shri Balesh Jannakatti FLD Farmer plots with banana farmers and 20 banana plants are de- navelled and tied with bunch feeding mixture.

Goats are among the main meat-producing animals in India, whose meat (chevon) is one of the choicest meats and has huge domestic demand. Due to its good economic prospects, goat rearing under intensive and semi-intensive system for commercial production has been gaining momentum for the past couple of years. High demand for goat and its products with potential of good economic returns have been deriving many progressive farmers, professionals and educated youths to take up the goat enterprise on a commercial scale. The emerging

favorable market conditions and easy accessibility to improved goat technologies are also catching the attention of entrepreneurs.

In this regard ICAR Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Bidar conducted 3 days Vocational training programme on "Scientific Goat Farming" for enhancing productivity and income generation from 27-02-2022 to 01-03-2023. Dr Narasappa, Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Bidar, inaugurated the programme by watering plant and in his inagural address he briefed about various schemes, insurance and importance of vaccination in goats. Water melon "Arka Shyama" in Pathanamthita district



Water melon cultivation is picking up in the district due to the heavy demand for watermelon during the summer months in the district. KVK Pathanamthita introduced the water melon crop in the district during the 2002- 2005 period. However the spread of the crop during later years slowed down due to difficulty in obtaining seeds, cracking of fruits due to unexpected rains etc. In order to evaluate the possibility of using watermelon as a summer crop for enhancing the profitability of crop production during the season, KVK conducted On Farm trials using Arka Shyama,

an open pollinated variety, KAU Shonima a seedless hybrid and Sugar baby the traditional variety as options for the trials. Arka Shyama outperformed the KAU Shonima and obtained yield of 37.6t/ha. Arka Shyama, an ice box type variety with dark greenish black rind, oblong fruit shape and is comparatively early maturing variety and attained crop maturity by 70 days from sowing. Most of the farmers were not able to successfully pollinate Shonima hybrid due to non-synchronized flowering in Pollinator variety sugar baby

Sponsored Training on Small Mushroom Grower at ICAR-KVK Hirehalli






